The owners (R&amp;J Ellwood) drained off the moat the filled it in and converted all into a really attractive site. Works cost £200. Land is now worth £5 a foot frontage. Owner has requested to have the valuation subdivided into plots (see separate valuations as per second sheets)".</p>
